I spent July 15-21 at THE ARK Christian Ministries. Without a doubt one of the highlights for me was our time spent on the Double Decker initiative.

I was particularly encouraged by Natalie. She is from my church but I really did not know her at all when we arrived at camp. I saw her watching those first kids go up. I could tell that she was interested but also scared. I called her over to me and I asked her if she was gonna try it. Her "no" was pretty emphatic. I told her that if she wanted to try I was willing to be her partner if it helped. After another "no" I gave her space. A few minutes later I asked if she had any thoughts. She replied that if she did, she wanted me up there with her..."but I'm 99.9% no." I told her I was going back to camp to get my shoes. She asked, "why?". I told her that there was a .01% chance that she's a yes and that I needed to be ready.

Finally as time was about to expire she said, "let's do this." We got up on the course and after the first challenge she went so fast I could hardly keep up with her. In the 2 Sundays since we have been back at church, Natalie has sought me out with big hugs; her family has been really moved by her entire camp story but a lot of it goes back to the Double Decker. She and I will always have that as a connection point.

This is the first summer the Double Decker High Ropes Course has been in use.

Thanks to the generosity of a few donors, half of the course was built this spring. Once completed, hopefully by spring 2022, this partnered challenge course will be able to host up to 32 participants at once.
