### Missionaries Summer 2017

Marcus and Arin Corn (pictured to the left) will serve as THE ARK's missionaries this summer. God has moved in their lives to put them on the path to full time ministry in Haiti beginning this fall. They're partnering with Haitian Christian Outreach as their Campus Managers. The compound where they will live includes a school, church, hospital and recreational areas open to the community. In addition to managing the campus, they will head up the Community Development area of the ministry. Using things like Compressed Earth Block manufacturing and raising small animals, they will help create sustainable jobs within the community.

The offerings given this summer will help **LAUNCH** them to Haiti. The cost of moving a family to another country can be expensive. We want to assist them in setting up in their new home. Since the HCO Campus is off the grid, one of the main things the money will be used for is a Solar Energy System for their home there.
