There are 6 camp styles to choose from at THE ARK.

(All onsite camps hear from the summer camp missionary daily.)

Main Camps: Conference-Style

These camps typically have over 100 campers in a high-energy, fast-paced, conference-style camp setting. Large-group worship, prayer, and Bible teaching happen daily. Campers sleep in bunk beds in the Lakeside Cabins, Cave, and/or Conference Center. All meals are served in the Conference Center. Camp sessions include: Quest, Extremes, Connect, Switch, Edge, & Merge.

Main Camps: Small Group-Style

Just like a team would get together to huddle up and talk about what they are going to do next, campers in these smaller main camp sessions come together to huddle up and then live out what they have learned. Worship through God's Word, song, prayer, and fellowship together are key parts of these camps. Plus, there's lots of time to enjoy group games and the fun activities around THE ARK. Campers and staff sleep in the Cave and/or Lakeside Cabins and eat meals in the Conference Center. Camp sessions include: Huddle-Up, S.T.E.M. 'N Nature, Pathways, & Encounter.

Jungle Huts

Students entering 4th-6th grade and ready for an adventure can escape civilization in the Jungle Hut Village. Built approximately 8 feet off the ground and connected by wooden walkways, the 4 enclosed rustic huts, covered gazebo, and open-air meeting space give campers a true "camping-out" experience. Campers sleep in bunk beds. Two meals a day are cooked over a campfire, and one meal is served in the Conference Center. Bring old clothes and shoes, and plan to hit the tire swing over the creek, do the swamp zip-line, canoe, and much more! (Registration size is limited.) Day camp option: Exploration Day.

Thai Huts

The four primitive huts that make up our Thai Huts compound foster a small-group dynamic in which strong friendships form, and memories are made. Campers sleep in huts over a wetland area and cook two meals a day there. One meal per day is served in the Conference Center. Campers explore life as part of God's community in a small group setting. Daily times of swimming, recreation, and more make this week a great experience. Relax and get to know your fellow campers as you encounter the laid-back nature of the culture the village is modeled after. (Registration size is limited.)

Horse Camps

Hoofprints Horse Camps provide young equestrians with the chance to spend the week building a relationship with Jesus while learning to care for a 4-legged friend. Days include exciting Bible lessons in between feeding, grooming, cleaning stalls, and riding professionally trained horses. Professionals closely monitor all activities. Each day (weather permitting), campers have a water activity such as swimming, and most days they'll have an additional camp activity. (Registration size is limited.)

Wilderness Camps

These camps travel off-site for an intense and immersive exploration of God and community through His creation. Locations change each year, so check the website for more info. (Registration size is limited.) Camps include: Intro to Wilderness, Junior High Wilderness, and High School Wilderness.
